# Conversation With Dr. Delius Wilson

When I asked Dr. Delius Wilson for an interview for the ABA Bulletin 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration issue, our 95-year-old nonagenarian knew he would be taking an unexpected trip down memory lane.



While serving as a high school principal in Brooklyn, New York, Dr. Wilson met Juanita Ward, an educator who was instrumental in transitioning him from rubber bridge to duplicate. In 2000, he joined the American Bridge Association. He recalls attending dozens of tournaments, each full of energy and seriousness, and brightly stated that he enjoyed meeting and socializing with

new people. Admittedly, Dr. Wilson did not consider himself a competitive player until his partnership with Hardy Hall, then members of the Co-op City Bridge Club in Bronx, New York. One of his memorable experiences was bidding a grand slam at a tournament against "top players." He strongly recommends something he did not have -- a mentor; and until you have one, new players, be diligent and be committed learners.

Today, Dr. Wilson is active playing bridge not only at the Mount Vernon DBC, his new home club, but also at other clubs within the Metropolitan Bridge Unit of New York. He is looking forward to MBU's "AAA" Tournament at Resorts Casino Hotel in Atlantic City, New Jersey this December.
